ALLPLAY Miracle League (ML) baseball for children with disabilities believes:



“ Every child deserves the chance to play baseball ! ”



In ALLPLAY Miracle League baseball:

- Every player bats once each inning;
- All players are safe on the bases;
- All players get team uniforms;
- Every player scores a run before the inning is over (last one up gets a home run!);
- Community children, volunteers, and family members are ‘buddies’ to assist the players;
- Each team and each player wins every game!

The thrill of playing, the cheers from the stands, and friendships developed make the ALLPLAY Miracle League an oasis away from their everyday battles. Miracle League parents tell stories of their children insisting on playing despite bouts with illness, kidney stones, broken bones, and recent hospitalizations.



Athlete's disabilities may include: autism; cerebral palsy; spina bifida; visual impairments; muscular dystrophy; dwarfism; multiple sclerosis; spinal cord injury; down syndrome, amputations, and other physical and mental disabilities.

Presently there are 200 Miracle League organizations across the country, 100 completed rubberized fields (including ALLPLAY's), and 100 fields under construction. The Miracle League is proud to serve over 80,000 children and young adults with disabilities.

- Games last approximately 1 hour 15 minutes.

Miracle League Buddies

“Buddies” assist Miracle League players. These buddies are adults, community youth, or family members who assist players during the game. As a result, parents, children, and volunteers are all brought together through sports in a positive and inspiring environment for everybody.



Miracle League Buddies can:

- Be assigned to a specific time slot;
- Choose to be assigned to a specific player (the player may be assigned a different game time each week);
- Be a part time buddy based on availability.

ALLPLAY Complex

ALLPLAY Complex is the nations finest barrier-free outdoor sports and recreation complex. The \$1.5 million dollar complex was built in Seymour Smith Park, located near 72nd and Harrison Street in Omaha. The complex is available for use by schools, civic, non-profit entities, and the public for activities and special events.

The entire ALLPLAY complex features barrier free design and level surfaces. The Miracle Field and playground are covered in rubber surfaces to soften falls. These surfaces are perfect for wheelchairs, walkers, braces, and use by people with visual impairment.

ALLPLAY Complex includes:

- Miracle League Baseball Field
- Wheelchair Softball Field
- Omaha's largest barrier free playground
- Welcome Center with concession stand and accessible restrooms
- Shaded picnic areas with assessable tables
- Water park (splash pad)
- 22 dedicated disabled parking spaces
